

Visual indicators

Several Allegion brands have products equipped with visual indicators to immediately alert a user about a door's locked or unlocked status—a beneficial feature both in everyday use as well as in emergencies.

In many applications, particularly in education, healthcare and commercial real estate, for example, indicators are part of the overall security plan. With indicators on locks or exit devices, an opening can be quickly assessed—from a distance—to determine if it is locked.

The convenience of using at-a-glance indicators to assess a lock saves time and alleviates confusion in the event of an emergency.

For convenience and privacy, many facilities also add indicators to doors for restrooms, conference rooms and private offices.

- Clear direction on the inside of the lock on how to safely and quickly secure a room

- Used for openings in corridors, assembly rooms and other large occupancy spaces
- At-a-glance verification of the lock status from inside a room
- Available as a new product or retrofit to an existing 98/99 device
- Status indicated by a small flag with Unlocked symbol (white background with black icon) that is visible when device is unlocked and disappears when it is locked
- Keyed cylinder or thumbturn are surrounded by Unlocked (white background with black icon) and Locked (red background with white icon) arrows to indicate how to secure the door quickly
