INSTALLATION PREPARATION



Door preparation:

Before installation, check the door for proper preparation.

3 Install chassis/outside spring cage assembly





TA501 with Key-in-Lever cylinder shown

IMPORTANT! Latch prongs fit above and below the slide and inside the chassis housing.



NOTE: For locks ordered "less cylinder" or for IC (Interchangeable Core) cylinders, see "For Lock Less Cylinder Only" on page 4 for instructions.

4 Install inside spring cage assembly

Fully tighten mounting screws. Lever catch faces door edge.

5 Install inside rose

5a Align the indent on the rose with the upper notch on the spring cage.



TA501, TA571 shown

5b Place the indent on the notch with the opposite side of the rose angled slightly away from the spring cage as shown.

Then, press the other side of the rose into place.

You should hear a click as the rose is pressed into place.



6 Install inside lever

FOR FUNCTIONS TA101, TA291, TA301, TA501, TA511, TA571, AND TA581 <u>ONLY</u> :

(For other functions, see note below.)

Push the inside lever onto the spindle.

Be sure to engage the lever catch.

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FOR LOCK LESS CYLINDER ONLY

INSTALL OUTSIDE CYLINDER (Skip if cylinder is already installed)

For all cylinders, rotate the outside keycam driver.



TA571 Function ONLY

Insert flat screwdriver into keycam and rotate clockwise until it stops.

For **KIL cylinder**, rotate counterclockwise slightly. For **IC cylinder**, rotate

counterclockwise until keycam is at 45 degree angle.



FOLLOW STEPS BELOW FOR APPLICABLE CYLINDER TYPE.

FOR KIL (Key in Lever) CYLINDER:

1. Place the cylinder assembly into the lever.

2. Insert the key and rotate 90 degrees clockwise.





90° clockwise

 With key still rotated 90 degrees clockwise, push outside lever onto the spindle.
Be sure to engage the lever catch.

Spacer must be installed on spindle.



4. Rotate the key counterclockwise to starting position and remove it from the cylinder.



FOR IC (Interchangeable Core) CYLINDER:

1. If the outside lever is not installed, push the lever onto the spindle. Be sure to engage the lever catch.

Spacer must be installed .



INSIDE OF LOCK

TA381 Vestibule Function ONLY

- A. Install strike, latch, chassis/spring cage assembly, and inside rose as shown in steps 1 through 5 (pages 2–3). If necessary, install outside lever and outside cylinder (see "For Lock Less Cylinder Only" on page 4).
- ① NOTE: TA381 cylinders use a short, straight tailpiece on the outside and a long, indented tailpiece inside. See page 1 for illustrations.

FOLLOW STEPS BELOW FOR APPLICABLE CYLINDER TYPE.

FOR KIL CYLINDER:

B. Adjust the **inside** cam position with timing tool:



E. With key still rotated 90 degrees clockwise, push inside lever onto the spindle. Be sure to engage the lever catch.

Spacer must be installed on spindle.



F. Rotate the key counterclockwise back to the starting position and remove the key.



FOR IC CYLINDER:

B. If the inside lever is not installed, push the lever onto the spindle. Be sure to engage the lever catch.

Spacer must be installed.



F. Rotate the key counterclockwise until it stops and remove the key from the cylinder.

LEVER REMOVAL

Closed lever

(TA101 inside and outside, or TA561, TA581 inside)

- 1. Push the lever catch with the pin wrench.
- 2. Pull off the lever while pushing on the pin wrench.



Lever with turn (TA291 or TA301, outside)

- 1. Push the lever catch with the pin wrench.
- 2. Pull off the lever while pushing on the pin wrench.



TA301 shown

Lever with KIL cylinder (inside or outside)

- 1. Insert key and turn 90 degrees clockwise.
- 2. Push the lever catch with the pin wrench.
- 3. Pull off the lever while pushing on the pin wrench.



IC cylinder and IC lever (inside or outside)

- 1. Insert control key and turn 15 degrees clockwise.
- 2. Pull out the cylinder.
- 3. Push the lever catch with the pin wrench.
- 4. Pull off the lever while pushing on the pin wrench.





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ROSE REMOVAL

- 1. Rotate the rose counterclockwise approximately 10°.
- 2. Then, remove the rose.



LOCK FUNCTIONAL TESTING

NOTICE

Test the lock with the door open to prevent being locked out.

TA101 Passage Function

- 1. Rotate inside lever. Rotation should be smooth and latch should retract.
- 2. Rotate outside lever. Rotation should be smooth and latch should retract.

TA301 Privacy Function

- 1. Push the inside button to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Rotate the inside lever to release the button and unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 3. Push the inside push button to relock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 4. Using a flat screwdriver, rotate the outside emergency turn to release the inside button. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 5. The inside lever should always be unlocked and rotate freely.

TA291 Hospital/Privacy Function

- 1. Push the inside push button to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Rotate the inside lever to release the button and unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 3. Push the inside push button to relock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 4. Rotate the outside emergency turn to release the inside button. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 5. The inside lever should always be unlocked and rotate freely.

TA381 Vestibule Function

- 1. Rotate the inside key <u>180 degrees counterclockwise</u> (to hard stop) and back to home to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Use the outside key to retract the latch when the door is locked.
- 3. Rotate the inside key <u>180 degrees clockwise</u> (to hard stop) and back to home to unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 4. The inside lever should always be unlocked and rotate freely.

TA501 Entrance/Office Function

- 1. Push the inside push button to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Rotate the inside lever to release the button and unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 3. Push the inside push button to relock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 4. Use the outside key to retract the latch and release the push button. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 5. The inside lever should always be unlocked and rotate freely.

TA511 Entrance Function

- 1. Push the inside push-turn button to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Rotate the inside lever to release the button and unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 3. Push the inside push-turn button to relock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 4. Use the outside key to retract the latch and release the push-turn button. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 5. Push and turn the inside push-turn button <u>90 degrees clockwise</u> to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 6. Use the outside key to retract the latch. The push-turn button should stay in the locked (depressed and turned) position.
- 7. Rotate the inside push-turn button <u>90 degrees counterclockwise</u> and then rotate the inside lever to release the inside push-turn button and unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 8. The inside lever should always be unlocked and rotate freely.

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TA561 Classroom Function

- 1. Rotate the outside key <u>225 degrees counterclockwise</u> (to hard stop), and back to home to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Rotate the outside key <u>225 degrees clockwise</u> (to hard stop), and back to home to unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 3. The inside lever should always be unlocked and rotate freely.

TA571 Corridor Function

Lock by outside key:

IMPORTANT: When locked by key, the outside lever remains locked until unlocked by key.

- 1. Rotate the outside key <u>160 degrees counterclockwise</u> (to semi-hard stop rotate an additional 60 degrees to retract the latch), and back to home to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Rotate the outside key <u>180 degrees counterclockwise</u> to release the push button, retract the latch and lock the outside lever by key. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 3. Rotate the outside key <u>180 degrees clockwise</u> (to hard stop) and back to home to unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.

Lock by inside push button:

IMPORTANT: To keep the outside lever locked, it <u>must be</u> locked by key as described above. If not locked by key, the outside lever will unlock when the inside lever is unlocked as described below.

NOTE: Before performing the following tests, check that the outside lever is unlocked by key as described above.

- 1. Push the inside push button to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Rotate the inside lever to release the push button and unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 3. With the door open, push the inside push button to relock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 4. Close the door or push in latch bolt to release the inside push button and unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.
- 5. Push the inside push button to relock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 6. Rotate the outside key <u>225 degrees clockwise</u> to release the push button, retract the latch and unlock the lock. Check that the locked is unlocked.
- 7. The inside lever should always be unlocked and rotate freely.

TA575 Classroom Security Function

- 1. Using either the inside or outside key, rotate key <u>225 degrees counterclockwise</u> (to hard stop), and back to home to lock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Using either the inside or outside key, rotate key <u>225 degrees clockwise</u> (to hard stop), and back to home to unlock the outside lever. Check that the outside lever is unlocked.

TA581 Storeroom Function

- 1. Check that the outside lever is locked.
- 2. Use the outside key to retract the latch.
- 3. The inside lever should always be unlocked and rotate freely.
