The Problem: In 2021, the LCN* team sat down with the facility and locks team at a prominent west coast university. The topic of discussion was automatic operators. At the time, the university used larger operators, which performed well on some doors but presented logistical challenges on their smaller or more unique openings. They reached out to LCN to help solve these challenges.

The Solution: That same year, LCN released a first-to-market solution, tailored for aftermarket upgrades and distinct applications. The 6400 COMPACT™ Automatic Operator is known for its ability to attach to and automate an existing 4040XP mechanical closer. This modular solution was significantly smaller than traditional automatic operators and could be mounted in a variety of ways to accommodate low

clearances, tight spaces, and historic setups built outside of today's standards. It was a perfect solution for the challenges this university was facing.

The Result: After installing their first 6400 COMPACT three years ago, this university now has nearly a dozen across their campus, with a few more in their shop, waiting to be installed. "We're happy with them. They install easily," said one of the lock shop team members. "They work well, and the programming is very simple." From exterior facing doors to interior bathrooms to access controlled entrances, the LCN COMPACT has helped improve ADA accessibility and overall convenience for both their students and staff.
